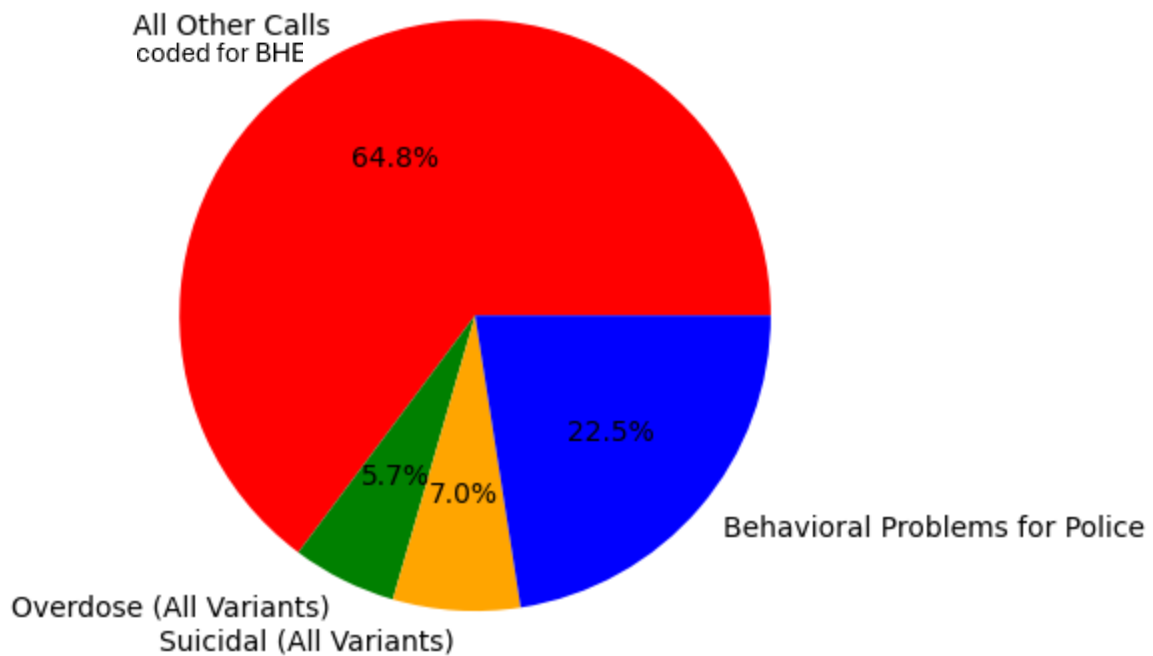


Call Distribution Coded for Behavioral Health Event (BHE)



The percentages for March 2026 calls coded for BHE

- Behavioral Problem for Police (All variants) → 22.5%
- Suicidal Person (All variants) → 7.0%
- Overdose (All variants) → 5.7%
- All Other Calls coded for BHE Combined → 64.8%

Combined Impact

The three selected behavioral-health-related call types together account for:

- 35.2% of all calls

That means roughly 1 out of every 3 calls falls into one of these three high-impact behavioral categories.

Total calls coded for BHE: 416

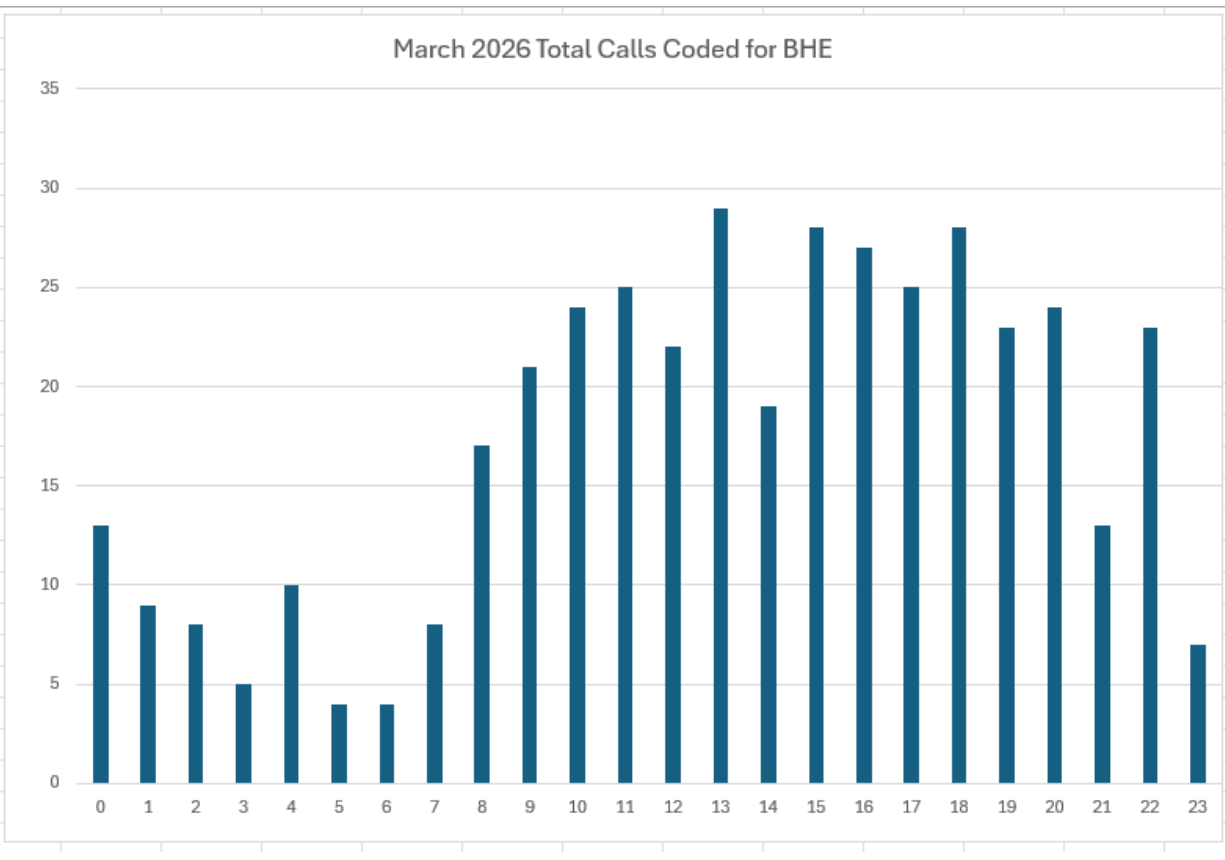

Charlottesville City: 22902, 22903

UVA: 22904, 22908

Albemarle County: 22901, 22911

Behavioral Health Problem (Any Variant)

- Charlottesville City: $37 + 45 = 82$
 - UVA: $0 + 0 = 0$
 - Albemarle County: $44 + 12 = 56$

Suicidal Person (Any Variant)

- Charlottesville City: $9 + 12 = 21$
 - UVA: $1 + 0 = 1$
 - Albemarle County: $8 + 5 = 13$
-

Overdose (Any Variant)

- Charlottesville City: $8 + 8 = 16$
 - UVA: $0 + 1 = 1$
 - Albemarle County: $6 + 3 = 9$
